Column labeled **T** shows when the Vision Trailer will be used, **X** for when school classroom is used.

The Eagle River Sleeping Ladies team (ERSL) takes care of the schools highlighted in green.

The Girdwood Turnagain Arm Lions team (GTAL) takes care of the schools highlighted in purple.

All screenings in the elementary schools will start at **8:30AM, (9:30AM on Mondays)** unless another time is shown on schedule. All health screenings should be completed before the end of the second quarter. The Team will do “pick-up” screening when needed (students missed at first screening at the school plus any new-to-district students)

The ASD guidelines for their health screenings:

Photoscreening- PreK, K, 1st and 2nd grade and those 3rd graders that failed distance acuity

Distance Acuity- 3rd, 5th, 7th, 10th and New to District for all grades and 1st graders that failed Photoscreening.

DA Criteria- For ages 3, 4, and 5: worse than 20/40 or a two line or greater difference between the eyes (even if in passing range) is a referral.
For 6 years and older: worse than 20/30 or a two line or greater difference the eyes (even if in passing range) is a referral.

Hearing- Hearing tests are mandated for students when they first enter the school

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system and then at regular intervals. ASD recommends hearing tests to occur at NTD, PK, K, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th & 10th grades. Screen 2nd grade if time and

staffing allow.

The tests involve pure-tone screening at specific frequencies and decibel

levels.

Color Vision-

To identify any deficiency in the ability to recognize color. One time screening for boys (girls optional) in pre-school, K, 1st grade or new to school district. Color deficiency is the inability to distinguish certain shades of colors- red, green, and yellow. Blue-yellow color deficiency is less common. It makes it distinguish between shades of blue and green and between yellow and red.

The nurse and principal at each individual school has the choice of following the district guidelines or having Our Vision Team do the screening for the entire school population. We find it is easier to identify problems or a change in the students' health screening if a complete annual history is available.


